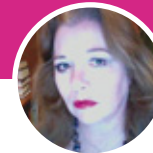

ARCHANGEL AZRAEL

Azrael is sometimes referred to as the 'Angel of Death', but the name should not produce feelings of fear, as Azrael is in fact one of the kindest and gentlest angels. The name really comes about from one of Azrael's main tasks, which is to guide souls that are crossing over.

Halloween Costumes

Are you going to a Halloween themed costume party? Then read on for the folklore behind some of the favoured Samhain costumes:

Ghost

Ghosts of course come in many guises, but the typical party costume is often made up of a white sheet to depict a frail and delicate ghost of a person. Which makes sense as 'ghost' is the term used for the apparition of the dead, and we often imagine that ghosts will be in human form, but often transparent or misty, demonstrating that they are no longer a whole being, but just the disembodied soul travelling the afterlife. Depending on your life experiences as to whether you will find a ghost scary or not, but for many they tap into our deepest fears about what life after death might hold!

Vampire

There is no doubt that modern television programmes have romanticised and popularised the vampire, making it a wellliked costume outfit. But earlier vampires were much more terrifying, not surprisingly as they are the 'undead' – a resurrected corpse! Vampires are in essence a type of ghost that leaves a grave at night-time to enter the world of the living. They are often depicted as superior beings, but in reality, these fictional characters cannot survive without humans, such is their need to drink their blood, and so then it is easier to see them just as the monsters they are.

Werewolf

To understand werewolves, you first have to go back to 'lycanthropy', which is a belief that it is possible through witchcraft to form into the shape of an animal. Werewolves are usually depicted in modern times as shape-shifting from a human being who looks perfectly normal, to a scathing and snarling deadly wolf-person. Legend says that you too could be turned into a werewolf should you succumb to a bite! The best way to view them now, is as a metaphor for life – some people will hide their true nature from you, and at the point their real personality is revealed you may find them to be cruel at heart.

Witch

There are different depictions of the witch, at a party you may see a sexy lady all dressed in black complete with a broom, cat or wand, or someone may choose the 'Pagan Triple Goddess' witch look – which is more haggard old lady, complete with pointy hat and warts aplenty. Of course, throughout times witches have been persecuted, but many that choose the costume will be complementing the folklore that witches are a magical self with the ability to achieve things that us mere mortals cannot! They have much experience, wisdom and compassion to offer.

Zombie

Zombies have also been commercialised through television programmes, in fact, zombies can be traced back to Voodoo traditions, a zombie was a reanimated corpse, seemingly resurrected from dead, to become a soulless indebted servant to his master. In this scenario it is unlikely that the person was actually dead, but merely suspended in time through a drug cocktail, and then buried alive. Some of these aspects are now being used to depict a breakdown in society, and the loss of control that people experience when abusing substances, so perhaps not the most poetic of costumes, although quite popular.

THE SCARY SIDE OF HALLOWEEN



Film franchises, perhaps especially horror franchises are not necessarily known for their quality, often they just become a commercial enterprise, full of a lot of cliché's and in the case of slasher movies, just a fresh approach on characters to kill off!

But the latest 'Halloween' film, is trying to sidestep that issue, by becoming a direct sequel to the original John Carpenter film of 1978. In doing so they are not chained by continuity issues of the franchise series of films that came after. This has given them the leeway to create a narrative that actually has a story, with an underlying theme of looking at the consequences that are far-reaching and long-lasting for the victims of trauma and violence.

Whilst a serious theme is addressed, don't be mistaken for thinking that this horror movie moves away from its 'slasher' origins, because it doesn't. There is plenty of violence and scenes of gore, but at the same time there is much humour, and a clever nod here and there to the previous films.

In the original film the character Michael Myers wears a white mask, and terrorises teenagers, choosing his victims based on topical issues of the day – young adults having sex, underage drinking and the like. This unstoppable force of nature kept going until he was stopped by the 'final girl' (Laurie Strode) – Jamie Lee Curtis.

Fast forward 40 years, and Michael Myers has escaped whilst being transferred to a new psychiatric facility. Laurie has lived her life after a fashion, with self-made survivalist tactics, whilst she went on to have a child, her daughter's childhood was not easy, as Laurie lived her life believing that one day she would need to fight Michael once more. Now it seems that might be true, and yet the stakes are even higher with her granddaughter Allyson at risk!

It is very difficult for any film to surpass the original, but this movie gives it the best shot. Those that like horror genre films, will like the nods to the original in terms of storyline, but also in the soundtrack and style of filming. Jamie Lee Curtis brings everything you imagine she would to the screen, being dark, fierce and wounded all at the same time. As you would expect there is lots of tension, the violence should not be underestimated it is shockingly brutal, and yet the film is punctuated with comedy.

In interviews Jamie Lee Curtis has said that one of the reasons for signing on to do the film was that she liked the fact the script explored the effects of the trauma, and how that one event passed on to the generations that came after.

The film is out in UK cinemas before Halloween on the 19th October 2018, watch it if you dare!

Halloween seems like the perfect time to discuss magic, as the season conjures up all things sorcery...

Magic is for many a combination of science and art; the science part is in researching witchcraft and following a specific spell and method, and the art comes in the form of your insights, intuition and creative abilities! Both elements are needed in order to alter the natural forces to bring about your will, and produce a new outcome.

BLACK MAGIC - WHITE MAGIC

No doubt you will have heard the terms 'Black Magic' and 'White Magic'. Magic that is used with the purpose of causing someone harm or being used to manipulate and circumvent free will is black magic, and white magic is where you wish to bring about a positive outcome.

But of course, things are not that simple, and life is not black and white. For example, if a person wished another to fall in love with them, then the desired outcome is a positive one, but it could not be achieved without influencing the will of the object of desire!

So, for some people the term black magic will be reserved for spells that draw on evil forces.

FOUR MAGIC TYPES

There are many forms of magic, but we are exploring four categories today:

- Ceremony Magic

As the name suggests, ceremonial magic is where props are used and particular rituals are performed, generally the process is accompanied by expansive words. Sometimes this type of magic is referred to as High Magic.

- Folk Magic

Superstitions and folklore fall into the category of folk magic. It can involve anything that a person might do to avoid something bad befalling them, such as carrying a rabbit's foot in their purse, to doing something after an event to avoid bad luck, such as throwing salt over a shoulder.

- Natural Magic

A person will harness energy from the planets, the moon and sun, as well as tools at their disposal, such as crystals, candles, herbs and more, to bring about positive changes.

- Sympathetic Magic

In sympathetic magic, objects are used to signify an outcome that is trying to be achieved. For example, if you wanted to make it rain, you would use turning on the shower as a representation of the desired outcome.



OGHAM DIVINATION

The Celts had an interesting way of divining the future; they would carve symbols onto wooden sticks, each stick would come from a different tree variety, and would each relate to a letter of the 'Ogham Alphabet', the symbols were carved along the central axis and were made up of short lines. Once complete the sticks were used in a very similar way to Runes to divine the future.

The symbols were known as 'Sigil', each one representing a guardian spirit that could be called upon for advice. There are twenty sigil's that make up the alphabet.

If you want to make an Ogham alphabet set yourself, then draw the symbols onto pieces of card, or even onto lolly sticks that you can purchase from craft stores.

When you are ready to ask your question, you can just choose to draw one random stick and interpret that sticks wording as your answer. For a more thorough look at your problem, it is better to randomly choose three sticks. Place the sticks in a vertical line, the first stick is concerned with the past – think of this as the roots of the tree. The second sticks represents things that need your attention in the present – think of this as the trunk of the tree. The last and third stick, signifies your future or the likely outcome to the question you are posing – think of this as the branches and foliage of the tree.

Ogham Alphabet Tree Interpretations (Tree/Sigil)



Alder – Fearn:

Self Protecting & Shielding, take courage and self-assurance from the Alder.



Apple – Quert:

This stick is all about your spiritual journey and being your whole most authentic self – heal your soul!



Ash – Nuin:

You are strong, you can be resilient – let the Ash tree empower you.



Aspen – Eadha:

Change is afoot, as a threshold tree Aspen signifies the gateway between the dead and the living. Don't interpret this as death, but as transition is near.



Birch – Beith:

It will seem as if negative energies have been magically lifted away and new beginnings fall in the space.



Blackberry – Muin:

As you might expect of the Blackberry – it is all about harvest, or put another way a plan coming to fruition, but grounded hard-work must come first.



Blackthorn – Straif:

The Blackthorn definitely brings forward magic, your own esoteric abilities, intuition and insights will rise!



Broom – Ngetal:

Take shelter with the Broom, let it shield you as you shake off negative thoughts and repeated bad patterns.



Elder – Ruis:

The Elder tree teaches us about respect, when we honour our past, we will be honouring our responsibilities and we will grow into our future.



Gorse – Onn:

Simply put - passion, love and fertility.



Hawthorn – Huath:

Trust yourself, especially in matters of the heart and love.



Hazel – Coll:

Be inspired by Hazel, let it guide you as you expand your knowledge, and wisdom will follow as you get to know others and yourself better.



Heather – Ur:

Go with the flow, so to speak. The Goddess will bring through healing.



Holly – Tinne:

Think of Holly as a 'life force' guiding you; feel the passion, and you will get through difficult times.



Ivy – Gort:

The intertwining of Ivy represents the connections we make and the support we give/receive from our ever-weaving circle of family and friends.



Oak – Duir:

Oak protects you and helps you to feel the power and control you have over yourself, be confident, be assertive!



Rowan – Luis:

You will be acutely aware of troubles ahead, but Rowan is highly protective.



Scots Pine – Ailm:

Imagine you were as tall as the Scots Pine, looking down on the picture that is your life! It's time to see the whole picture and take the long view.



Willow – Saille:

This tree can help you dream, but helpful lucid dreams that have something to say – they provide both encouragement and healing.



Yew – Idho:

When deciding on anything, we should consider our divine selves, but should also consider both our past ancestors and future generations to be.

You might not think of paranormal activities being something that regular people experience, perhaps you imagine these things belong in the lives of psychics and mediums only or in the land of television... Well, in fact, paranormal occurrences quite readily happen in everyday lives, so it is quite possible you have already experienced one of the five we are going to talk about today, or at least you might experience one of them in your lifetime!

You most likely have had dreams that you can remember, but precognitive dreams vary to normal dreams, in that a person is able to perceive of information about certain events before they happen whilst in a dream state. You do not have to have psychic abilities, to have a precognitive dream, most of us have the ability at some point to have insightful dreams and visions through the power of ESP – extra sensory perception. You may well have experienced a dream like this, and when the dreamed about event occurred, you most likely put it down to coincidence, and perhaps you felt like there was a ‘*déjà vu*’ moment! Others will take such dreams more seriously, and will use the information to change paths, thereby heeding the advance warning and potentially changing the future outcome.

Obviously, a near death experience is a much rarer occurrence, and not one that you would wish to experience, but there are some circumstances, such as an accident or operation where people for a small window of time get a glimpse of what's on 'the other side'. NDE's are often described as feeling like levitation, with a sense of pure peace and serenity. Often a bright light is present, in other cases people see everything from deceased loved ones to religious figures, but for others it is like they are having an 'out of body' experience, as if they are watching themselves in real-time.

Many of us will be able to tell of a time when we have felt a spiritual presence in our lives, whether we choose to call that or believe it is a ghost, angel or a loved one's spirit is for each of us to decide. But generally, in these encounters, the spiritual force has found a way to communicate with us, and to let their presence be known. This can range from a feather dropping from the sky, to cold spots appearing in and around your home, to having a goose bumps feeling across your body.

An 'out of body' experience is the easiest way to describe astral projection, you are seemingly out of your physical body, but are consciously aware. For many this will happen whilst meditating, or when communicating with a higher realm, but again is not limited to psychically gifted individuals. Many people feel like they are/could literally fly during the experience, they may meet those from another realm and feel like they have achieved a different ethereal perspective.

Given a unique set of circumstances, you may experience psychic empathy, an ability to feel and sense the physical pain and emotions of another. Twins often have this ability, but it is also often demonstrated between close family members, when they have a sixth sense that something is wrong.
